Adverbs - Use

Adjektive beziehen sich auf Nomen oder Pronomen.

Sie stehen vor dem Nomen oder

attributiver Gebrauch

*Yesterday the we had **fine** weather.
My friend has got a **fast** car.
Clever students get **good** marks.*

nach dem Verb

(Weiteres dazu siehe Gebrauch der Adjektive.)

prädikativer Gebrauch

*The weather **is fine** today.
This Italian car **is fast**.
These students **are clever**. Their marks **are good**.*

Adverbien können sich beziehen auf

den ganzen Satz

***Unfortunately** I have forgotten my money.
Obviously he isn't interested in our plans.
Next week I'll **probably** go to London.
Possibly, there is no solution for our problem.*

Verben

*My mother drives **carefully**.
He supports ManU **fanatically**.
She **quickly** left the room.
Calmly she turned and left him alone.*

Adjektiv

*She was **very** disappointed.
My father was **terribly** angry.
This book is **rather** interesting.
You're **absolutely** right.*

Adverb

*My mother drives **very** carefully.
He runs **really** quickly.
She speaks Italian **nearly** perfectly.
He **almost** always forgets his homework.*
