2. We have free tickets. (usually)
3. I have tasted garlic. (never, up to now)
4. I see him. (these days, rarely)
5. He had a feeling of danger. (unexpectedly, at once)
6. Do you cycle to school? (regularly)
7. My brother and I go for long walks. (at the weekends, often)
8. My father works. (hard, in the garden, most weekends)
9. My mother does the homework. (seldom, during the day)
10. She does her shopping. (quickly, during lunch break, very often)
11. I leave for school. (on weekdays, at seven thirty, usually)
12. I stay in bed. (until noon, on Sundays, every now and then)
13. I wouldn't like to live in a busy place. (honestly)
14. The old lady crossed the street. (slowly, without looking)
15. The sports car approached the zebra crossing and had to brake. (sharply, at high speed)
16. There was a lot of traffic in the city centre. (during the rush hour, every day)
17. It took my Dad an hour to get home. (today)
18. He opened the bottle. (carefully)
